

AusCycling Community Instructor Course

Pre-Requisites and General Information

Before you can start the course, you must be:

1. Aged 14 or over.
2. A current AusCycling Non-Rider member (as a minimum). If you ride your bike during your instructing session you must have a Lifestyle, Off-Road Race or All Discipline Race membership. Membership details can be found [HERE](#)

Course Cost:

- Community Instructor – Assistant - \$50
- Mini-Wheelers add on module (requires Community Instructor – Assistant) – Free
- School Teacher' BMX Track add on module (requires Community Instructor – Assistant) - \$50

In addition to the online course work, the following pre-requisites are needed to complete your accreditation. These are not required to start the course but must be completed and the certificates uploaded to the ETrainU Learning Management System, and checked by AusCycling, before your Community Instructor accreditation can be finalised. Note this process can take up to 2 business days.

1. Hold a valid Working with Children Check (or equivalent) as per your State/Territory requirements. The age at which a WWCC is required and where to apply for each state is listed below.

2. Hold a current First Aid Certificate (Provide First Aid - HLTAID003 or higher). Courses are available Australia wide. Major providers include [St John](#) and [Australian Red Cross](#).
3. Complete the [Play by the Rules – Child Protection Online Course](#).
4. Complete the [SIA Clean Sport 101 Course](#).
