

AusCycling Development Instructor - MTB

The AusCycling Development Instructor - MTB course (previously known as the MTBA Level 1 MTB Skills Instructor) is a two-day theory and trail intensive aimed at Level 0 MTB Instructor & Foundation Instructor - MTB accredited members wanting to accelerate their instructing to the next level. Upon successful completion participants will be equipped to teach cyclo-cross style mounting and dismounting, cornering, pumping the trail, track stands, riding rock gardens, small step ups, small drop-offs, steep climbs and switchbacks on blue trails.

The Development Instructor – MTB Course will feature an emphasis on instructor's ability to demonstrate trail riding skills to best industry standard as well as consolidation of introductory instructing methods.

Accreditation will involve a pre-course trail audit and a two-day course split between theory sessions and plenty of time on the trail. Assessments will include pre-course trail audit, instructing on a blue trail, risk management documentation and trailside mechanical repairs. There are no post course requirements and successful participants will gain their accreditation at the end of the course.

Currently this course is available only for MTB, the other disciplines are in development and will be released in due course. To keep in the loop enter your details into the expression of interest list.

Below are the pre-requisites required to attend the Development Instructor - MTB course:

- Be at least 18 years of age
- Be a financial member of AusCycling or a legacy organisation
- Hold a current recognized First Aid certificate (Provide First Aid – HLTAID003/HLTAID011 as a minimum)
- Hold a current Working with Children Check that meets State/Territory legislation
- Be an accredited AC Foundation Instructor - MTB or MTBA Level 0 Mountain Bike Skills Instructor
- Completed 20 hours of logged instructing since completing Foundation Instructor - MTB or Level 0 Mountain Bike Skills Instructor course
- Complete the Pre Course Local Trail Audit worksheet
