3 EVENT ENTRIES

3.1 EVENT CATEGORIES

The below categories will be run by Nerang BMX Club at the 2021 AusCycling BMX National Cup Rounds 3 & 4. In order for a category to be held, at least five riders must be registered in that category.

Masters (Open Wheel – 20" or 24")*	Female	30+
Junior Superclass	Male & Female	14-16
Superclass	Male & Female	16+
<i>* if entering the masters category, riders cannot enter another 20" category</i>		

Please Note: Riding up is not permitted at National Cup rounds.

3.2 ENTRY PROCESS & COST

Entry will be online via EntryBoss only. Entries will be uploaded into Sqorz after entries have closed. It is the rider's/rider's guardian's responsibility to ensure that their entry is correct. This includes transponder number, category, and plate number.

Please Note: The Saturday and Sunday events are separate, riders must ensure they are registered for both events.

Riders who have entered and are no longer able to attend, can use the EntryBoss scratching mechanism prior to 22:00, Wednesday 27 October 2021. After this time, a Medical Certificate/COVID-19 test result must be provided to committee@nerangbmx.org.au, in order to receive a refund.

3.3 LICENCES

The events will be open to all riders holding an AusCycling Competition Licence for All Disciplines or Competition Licence for Off Road Disciplines only or BMXA Open, Sprocket, Mini Wheeler Licence.

3.4 TRANSPONDERS

- All riders (except Sprockets and Mini Wheelers) will need to provide their own transponder to enter this event.
- 20" and 24" bikes will need separate transponders unless prior approval has been received.
- It is the riders responsibility to ensure that the transponder is correctly fitted to their bike and is operational which includes an active [subscription](#).
- Transponders can be purchased [here](#).

3.5 RACE PLATES

- Riders must ensure they have the correct Race Plate as detailed under section 3.02 of the [AusCycling Technical Regulations – BMX](#).
- Riders with duplicate plates in the same category may be required to add an 'X' on their race number.

3.6 EVENT REGISTRATION (SIGN ON)

- All riders are required to attend the Event Registration (sign on).
- Should riders be participating in both rounds (i.e. Saturday and Sunday), they will not need to attend registration on the second day.
- All riders must take their bikes to the transponder checking station to register for the event.
- Riders entered in two (2) categories (i.e. 20" and 24") must take both bikes to register in both categories.
- Parents, guardians must scan Sprocket/Mini Wheeler licences at the transponder checking station.
- It is the responsibility of the rider/parent/guardian to check all details are correct at the transponder checking station.

4 RACE INFORMATION

4.1 RULES AND REGULATIONS

The event will be conducted under the rules and regulations of AusCycling Australia (AC) and the Union Cycliste Internationale (UCI).

4.2 RACE FORMAT

Current UCI Rules apply using Scrambled Moto transfer system for all categories except for participation. Block format may apply pending rider entries. Gate positions for Motos will be random computer drawn. Total points to end of motos followed by Qualifiers and Finals. Gate positions for Qualifiers and Finals are in order of lap time from the previous Stage or Round.

A category of one (1) full gate or less (i.e. eight (8) riders or less riders) will be run in accordance with section 2.03.03 a) of the [AusCycling Technical Regulations – BMX](#).

The race format for the 2021 AusCycling BMX National Cup Rounds 3 and 4 at Nerang BMX Club is as follows:

5 AWARDS & PRIZING

5.1 SPROCKETS AND MINI WHEELERS

All Sprockets and Mini Wheelers will receive an award for participation.

5.2 CHALLENGE, MASTERS, JUNIOR SUPERCLASS AND SUPERCLASS CATEGORIES

For Challenge, Masters, Junior Superclass and Superclass categories, the following will be provided:

Challenge (Standard 20" and Cruiser 24")	Prize Money	1st Place (\$50), 2nd Place (\$30), 3rd Place (\$20), 4th – 8th Place (\$10)
Masters	Prize Money	1st Place (\$100), 2nd Place (\$60), 3rd Place (\$40), 4th – 8th Place (\$20)
Junior Superclass	Prize Money*	1st Place (33%), 2nd Place (23%), 3rd Place (14%), 4th – 8th Place (8%)
Superclass	Prize Money^	1st Place (33%), 2nd Place (23%), 3rd Place (14%), 4th – 8th Place (8%)
* \$400 prize pool per round, plus 50% payback		
^ \$1,600 prize pool per round, plus 50% payback		

For Superclass & Junior Superclass categories 50% payback will be based on the entries per gender (i.e. 50% of male Superclass entry fees will go into the male Superclass prize pool, and 50% of female Superclass entry fees will go into the female Superclass prize pool).

Please Note: Merged Category payouts will be in accordance with [UCI Part 6 Technical Regulations](#) 6.1.014.



5.3 DISTRIBUTION OF AWARDS / PRIZE MONEY

Mini Wheelers, Sprockets, Challenge and Masters categories will be issued their awards/prize money on the day at the conclusion of the final (or last race for each category).

Junior Superclass and Superclass categories will receive their prize money via EFT (as soon as is reasonably practical following the event). Riders are to provide their bank details via email to committee@nerangbmx.org.au.

6 VENUE INFORMATION

The following are prohibited at Nerang BMX Club:

- Pets
- Alcohol
- Smoking (including E-Cigarettes or other vaping devices)

Parking for this event will be in the Nerang BMX Club Car Park.

All attendees at the 2021 AusCycling BMX National Cup Rounds 3 and 4 at Nerang BMX Club are required to adhere to the [AusCycling Code of Conduct](#). Failure to do so, or to follow any reasonable direction provided by AusCycling, Nerang BMX Club, or appointed officials at the event, may result in removal from the venue or exclusion from competition.

8 COVID-19

Nerang BMX Club in conjunction with AusCycling will continue to monitor the COVID-19 situation and will act in accordance with the advice of the relevant Government.

In the event that Government restrictions change and the event is unable to proceed, or an individual who has registered is now unable to travel due to border closures, a refund will be issued.

Who should not attend?

- To ensure the health and safety of all participants no participants are to attend if they have had any illness or symptoms of COVID-19.
- Participants must not attend if in the last 14 days they have been unwell or had close contact with a known or suspected case of COVID-19 (cough, sore throat, fever or shortness of breath), even if mild.
- Participants must not attend if they have been to a declared hot spot.
- Participants must leave immediately if they demonstrate any symptoms of COVID-19 during the event.

APPENDIX 1: NATIONAL CUP INFORMATION

WHAT IS THE NATIONAL CUP?

The AusCycling BMX National Cup is a series of events where riders can earn points in Platinum, Gold and Silver events. Series events can start on 1 January and last until the AusCycling National BMX Championships. The AusCycling BMX National Cup is designed to provide a clear progression pathway from State/Territory competition to the National level. The National Cup will build momentum by leading through State and National events to State/Territory Championships and culminate in the AusCycling National BMX Championships.

WHAT IS THE FORMAT?

The AusCycling BMX National Cup includes races from across Australia including State/Territory Series, State/Territory Championships, nominated National events and the AusCycling National BMX Championships.

Throughout the season riders are awarded points from their best results from up to eight (8) races which include:

- Best four (4) BMX Silver Races (State/Territory Series): this includes up to three (3) BMX State Series Rounds + the BMX State/Territory Championships.
- Best four (4) BMX National Races: this includes up to three (3) National Rounds + the BMX National Championships.

Please Note: Bronze Level (Open) events are not part of the National Cup.
