

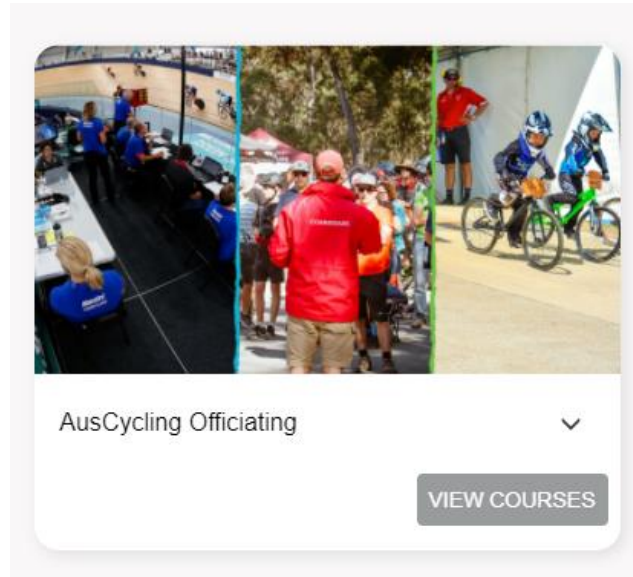
Regional Commissaire – BMX Course

If you have previously completed the BMXA Club Official Course and obtained your accreditation prior to the commencement of AusCycling your accreditation will need to be established in the e-learning system so you can enrol into the Regional Commissaire – BMX course.

Please follow these steps to enable this recognition:

1. Open your e-learning account by visiting:

2. Complete the process to enrol into the **BMX Club Officials Course**.
3. When registering please upload your Working with Children Check (WWCC). This will enable it to be stored in the e-learning system for any future courses. Your recognition as a BMX Official will not be able to be progressed until your WWCC is either uploaded or such a time that your membership records can be checked to validate a current WWCC.

If you have an existing an etrainu account, log into your account, go to the My Training, and click on AusCycling Officiating (screenshot below) and enrol into the **BMX Club Officials** course.



4. You will receive a confirmation of course registration. Forward this email to officials@auscycling.org.au with your name and AusCycling membership number.
5. You will receive a confirmation email once we have updated your etrainu account recognising the previous completion of the BMX Official course and you will then be able to enrol into the Regional Commissaire – BMX course.
