



**Guidelines on Commissaire Requirements State/Territory Level Road Events
(Appointments by AusCycling)**

Critical Considerations:

*All types of road races have a variety of considerations when determining the number of Commissaires. Depending on the course and number of riders additional Commissaire may be appointed.

**The number of assistant judges will be dependent on the nature of the event. For example, if there are intermediate sprint points assistant judges may be required. Additionally, if the race is expected to finish in a bunch sprint, or, if there is no photo finish equipment, more assistant judges would be required.

The PCP cannot act as Race Director under any circumstances

Under no circumstances can a Commissaire race in the same event as they are appointed in a Commissaire role

Road Handicaps

***In the case of small bunches or close time gaps a Commissaire may not be required for each bunch.

Road Race and Handicap

The PCP will also take the role of following a bunch.

Specific roles may include

Time Trial

- The Finish Judge role for a Time Trial would be the Starter. The Timekeeper role will be positioned at the finish line to record the times of the riders. An assistant finish judge can be stationed at the finish line to support the Timekeeper in recording order across the finish line. An assistant Timekeeper is required if there is an intermediate timing point.
- Turn around
- Roaming Commissaire
- Bike Check

Junior events

- A Commissaire must be assigned to undertake the rollout.

(Appointments by Host)**

Handicap	1	1 per bunch**	1
Road Race	1	1 per bunch	1
Time Trial	1	0-2	1

*These roles are generally conducted by the same person.

**In the case where bunch are close to each other or small a Commissaire may not be required.

Criterium

The number of Commissaires will depend on the course design and number of starters

It is feasible at a Club Criterium only for an experienced PCP to also act as Race Director

Road Race and Handicap

The PCP will also take the role of following a bunch.
