## 3 EVENT ENTRIES

### 3.1 EVENT CATEGORIES

The below categories will be run for this event. In order for a category to be held, at least four (4) riders must be registered in that category.

Challenge (20")	Male/Female	8, 9, 10, 11, 12, 13, 14, 15, 16, 17-24, 25-29, 30-34, 35-39, 40-44, 45-49, 50-54, 55-59, 60+
Challenge (Cruiser)	Male/Female	8-10, 11-12, 13-14, 15-16, 17-24, 25-29, 30-34, 35-39, 40-44, 45-49, 50-54, 55-59, 60+
30+ Open Wheel	Male/Female	30+
Junior Superclass	Male/Female	14-16
Superclass	Male/Female	16+

## 3.2 ENTRY PROCESS & COST

Entry will be online via EntryBoss only. Entries will be uploaded into Sgorz after entries have closed. It is the rider's/rider's guardian's responsibility to ensure that their entry is correct. This includes transponder number, category, and plate number.

## 3.3 MEMBERSHIP

- The events will be open to all riders holding an AusCycling All Discipline Membership or Off-Road Membership.

## 3.4 TRANSPONDERS

- All riders (except Participation Categories) will need to provide their own transponder to enter this event.
- 20" and 24" bikes will need separate transponders unless prior approval has been received.
- It is the rider's responsibility to ensure that the transponder is correctly fitted to their bike and is operational which includes an active [subscription](#).
- Transponders can be purchased [here](#).

## 3.5 RACE PLATES

- Riders must ensure they have the correct Race Plate as detailed under section 3.02 of the [AusCycling Technical Regulations – BMX](#).
- Riders with duplicate plates in the same category may be required to add an 'X' on their race number.

## 3.6 EVENT REGISTRATION (SIGN ON)

- All riders are required to attend the Event Registration (sign on).
- All riders must take their bikes to the transponder checking station to register for the event.
- Riders entered in two (2) categories (i.e., 20" and 24") must take both bikes to register in both categories.
- It is the responsibility of the rider/parent/guardian to check all details are correct at the transponder checking station.

# 4 RACE INFORMATION

## 4.1 RULES AND REGULATIONS

The event will be conducted under Technical Regulations of AusCycling Australia (AC) and the Union Cycliste Internationale (UCI).

## 4.2 RACE FORMAT

Current UCI Rules applies using Scrambled Moto transfer system for all categories except for participation. Block format may apply pending rider entries. Gate positions for Motos will be random computer drawn. Total points to end of mottos followed by Qualifiers and Finals. Gate positions for Qualifiers and Finals are in order of lap time from the previous Stage or Round.

A category of one (1) full gate or less (i.e., eight (8) riders or less riders) will be run in accordance with section 2.03.03 a) of the [AusCycling Technical Regulations – BMX](#).

The race format for the 2022 AusCycling BMX State Series – VIC R3 is as follows:

## 5 AWARDS & PRIZING

The following awards and prizing will be provided for Round 2:

Junior Superclass	<b>Prize Pool</b> \$250 – Junior Superclass Men \$250 – Junior Superclass Women	1st Place (33%), 2nd Place (23%), 3rd Place (14%), 4th Place (8%), 5th Place (7%), 6th Place (6%), 7th Place (5%), 8th Place (4%)
Superclass	<b>Prize Pool + 75% Payback (for 16 or more riders) ^</b> \$800 – Superclass Men \$800 – Superclass Women	1st Place (33%), 2nd Place (23%), 3rd Place (14%), 4th Place (8%), 5th Place (7%), 6th Place (6%), 7th Place (5%), 8th Place (4%)
<i>^ 75% payback will be based on the entries per gender (i.e. 75% of Superclass Men entry fees will go into the Superclass Men prize pool if 16 or more riders enter, and 75% of Superclass Women entry fees will go into the Superclass Women prize pool if 16 or more riders enter).</i>		

Awards and prizing will be issued based on categories run on the day and not where riders enter (i.e. in the case of merged categories).

### 5.1 DISTRIBUTION OF AWARDS / PRIZE MONEY

Mini Wheelers, Sprockets, Challenge and 30+ Open Wheel categories will be issued their awards/prize money on the day at the conclusion of the final (or last race for each category).

Junior Superclass and Superclass categories will receive their prize money via EFT (as soon as is reasonably practical following the event). Riders are to provide their bank details via email to [bendigobmx@hotmail.com](mailto:bendigobmx@hotmail.com).
