3 EVENT ENTRIES

3.1 EVENT CATEGORIES

The below categories will be run for this event. In order for a category to be held, at least four (4) riders must be registered in that category. BMX Technical Regulations, Section 1.03. Further information specific to Riding Up, Merged Categories and Tie Break can be found within the 2022 AusCycling Queensland BMX State Series Regulations.

Junior Superclass	Male/Female	14-16
Superclass	Male/Female	16+

3.2 ENTRY PROCESS & COST

Entry will be online via EntryBoss only. Entries will be uploaded into Sgorz after entries have closed. It is the rider's/rider's guardian's responsibility to ensure that their entry is correct. This includes transponder number, category, and plate number. <https://our.sgorz.com/org/bmxq>.

3.3 MEMBERSHIP

- The events will be open to all riders holding an AusCycling All Discipline Membership or Off-Road Membership. A proof of a current membership maybe required during the confirmation process prior to racing.

3.4 TRANSPONDERS

- All riders (except Participation Categories) will need to provide their own transponder to enter this event.
- 20" and 24" bikes will need separate transponders unless prior approval has been received.
- It is the riders responsibility to ensure that the transponder is correctly fitted to their bike and is operational which includes an active [subscription](#).
- Transponders can be purchased [here](#).

3.5 RACE PLATES

- Riders must ensure they have the correct Race Plate as detailed under section 3.02 of the [AusCycling-Technical-Regulations-BMX](#).
- Riders with duplicate plates in the same category may be required to add an 'X' on their race number.

3.6 EVENT REGISTRATION (SIGN ON)

- All riders are required to attend the Event Registration (sign on).
- All riders must take their bikes to the transponder checking station to register for the event.
- Parents, guardians must register Mini Wheelers and Sprocket licenses at the transponder checking station or directly with Registration prior to practice/racing.
- Riders entered in two (2) categories (i.e. 20" and 24") must take both bikes to register in both categories.
- It is the responsibility of the rider/parent/guardian to check all details are correct at the transponder checking station.
- Failure to complete the registration/confirmation process may mean your rider is withdrawn from racing.

4 RACE INFORMATION

4.1 RULES AND REGULATIONS

The event will be conducted under Technical Regulations of AusCycling Australia (AC) and the Union Cycliste Internationale (UCI).

4.2 RACE FORMAT

Current UCI Rules apply using Scrambled Moto transfer system for all categories except for participation. Block format may apply pending rider entries. Gate positions for Motos will be random computer drawn. Total points to end of motos followed by Qualifiers and Finals. Gate positions for Qualifiers and Finals are in order of lap time from the previous Stage or Round.

A category of one (1) full gate or less (i.e. eight (8) riders or less riders) will be run in accordance with section 2.03.03 a) of the [AusCycling-Technical-Regulations-BMX](#).

The race format for the AusCycling Queensland BMX State Series Round 5 is as follows:

Junior Superclass	3 Motos, Qualifiers, Finals
Superclass	3 Motos, Qualifiers, Finals

5 AWARDS & PRIZING

5.1 MINI WHEELER & SPROCKETS

All riders will receive an award for participation. Please ensure that you nominate prior to the advised cut off.

5.2 CHALLENGE, 30+ OPEN WHEEL, JUNIOR SUPERCLASS AND SUPERCLASS CATEGORIES

For Challenge, 30+ Open Wheel, Junior Superclass and Superclass categories, the following will be provided:

Challenge (20" and Cruiser)	Prize Money	1st Place (\$50), 2nd Place (\$30), 3rd Place (\$20), 4th – 8th Place (\$10)
30+ Open Wheel	Prize Money	1st Place (\$100), 2nd Place (\$60), 3rd Place (\$40), 4th – 8th Place (\$20)
Junior Superclass	Prize Money*	As per AusCycling BMX Regulations 5.02.02 (1st – 8th)
Superclass	Prize Money^	As per AusCycling BMX Regulations 5.02.02 (1st – 8th)
<i>Total Prize Pool for Superclass and Junior Superclass split 50:50 Female/Male</i>		
<i>* \$400 prize pool per round, plus 50% payback</i>		
<i>^ \$1,600 prize pool per round, plus 50% payback</i>		

For Superclass & Junior Superclass categories 50% payback will be based on the entries per gender (i.e. 50% of male Superclass entry fees will go into the male Superclass prize pool, and 50% of female Superclass entry fees will go into the female Superclass prize pool).

Please Note: Merged Category payouts will be based on Race Class.

5.3 DISTRIBUTION OF AWARDS / PRIZE MONEY

Mini Wheelers, Sprockets, Challenge and 30+ Open Wheel categories will be issued their awards/prize money on the day at the conclusion of the final (or last race for each category).

Junior Superclass and Superclass categories will receive their prize money via EFT (as soon as is reasonably practical following the event). Riders are to provide their bank details via email to secretaryhcbmx@gmail.com].

6 VENUE INFORMATION
