3 EVENT ENTRIES

3.1 EVENT CATEGORIES

The below categories will be run for this event. In order for a category to be held, at least four (4) riders must be registered in that category.

3.2 ENTRY PROCESS & COST

Entry will be online via EntryBoss only. Entries will be uploaded into Sqorz after entries have closed. It is the rider's/rider's guardian's responsibility to ensure that their entry is correct. This includes transponder number, category, and plate number.

3.3 SCRATCHING & REFUNDS

Riders who have entered and are no longer able to attend, can use the EntryBoss scratching mechanism prior to the scratching cut off listed above in section 3.2. If a rider scratches in EntryBoss prior to the scratching cut off date, they will automatically be refunded the entry fee via EntryBoss.

After the scratching cut off date has passed, in order to obtain a refund, riders must request a refund via email to events@auscycling.org.au, with a copy of their medical certificate attached. The refund request and medical certificate must be received by AusCycling prior to race day (for clarity this is prior to INSERT DATE). For more information, please view the AusCycling Refund Policy.

3.4 MEMBERSHIP

 The events will be open to all riders holding an AusCycling All Discipline Membership or Off-Road Membership.

3.5 TRANSPONDERS

- All riders (except Participation Categories) will need to provide their own transponder to enter this event.
- 20" and 24" bikes will need separate transponders unless prior approval has been received.
- It is the riders responsibility to ensure that the transponder is correctly fitted to their bike and is operational which includes an active <u>subscription</u>.
- Transponders can be purchased here.

3.6 RACE PLATES

- Riders must ensure they have the correct Race Plate as detailed under section 3.02 of the <u>AusCycling</u> Technical Regulations – BMX.
- Riders with duplicate plates in the same category may be required to add an 'X' on their race number.

3.7 EVENT REGISTRATION (SIGN ON)

- All riders are required to attend the Event Registration (sign on), prior to the commencement of their Official Practice session.
- All riders must take their bikes to the transponder checking station to register for the event.
- Riders entered in two (2) categories (i.e. 20" and 24") must take both bikes to register in both categories.
- Parents/guardians must scan Sprocket/Mini Wheeler membership at the Event Registration area, but they are not required to bring bikes with them.
- It is the responsibility of the rider/parent/guardian to check all details are correct at the transponder checking station.

4 RACE INFORMATION

4.1 RULES AND REGULATIONS

The event will be conducted under Technical Regulations of AusCycling Australia (AC) and the Union Cycliste Internationale (UCI).

These Technical Regulations are supplementary to the following:

- AusCycling Technical Regulations General
- AusCycling Technical Regulations BMX

4.2 RACE FORMAT

Current UCI Rules apply using Scrambled Moto transfer system for all categories except for participation. Block format may apply pending rider entries. Gate positions for motos will be determined using scrambled seeding. Total points to end of motos followed by Qualifiers and Finals. Gate positions for Qualifiers and Finals are in order of lap time from the previous Stage or Round.

A category of one (1) full gate or less (i.e. eight (8) riders or less riders) will be run in accordance with section 2.03.03 a) of the AusCycling Technical Regulations – BMX.

The race format for the NSW State Series is as follows:

Category	Race Format
Mini Wheelers/Sprockets	4 Motos
Challenge/30+ Open Wheel/ Junior Superclass/ Superclass	3 Motos, Qualifiers, Finals

Riders will need Advanced Riders Accreditation to enter a category that will race on a track with advanced sections

4.3 RIDERS ADVOCATE / PROTESTS

4.3.1 APPOINTMENT AND ROLE OF RIDERS ADVOCATE

A Riders Advocate (also known as Team Manager) will be appointed by the Race Director for each round of the 2022 AusCycling BMX ACT/NSW State Series rounds. The Riders Advocate represents a rider in relation to appeals concerning procedural matters. Where there are large number of riders attending the event, the Race Director may also appoint additional Assistant Riders Advocates, in order to assist the Riders Advocate in their role.

4.3.2 PROCESS TO LODGE A PROTEST

All riders must approach the Riders Advocate to speak to officials if they have an issue / lodge a protest on their behalf. Protests can only be made on the results from the scoring medium showing the order in which the riders crossed the finish line, not the decisions of the commissaires panel that are noted in the results such as DNS (Did Not Start), DNF (Did Not Finish), REL (Relegated).

5 AWARDS & PRIZING

Superclass

5.1 SPROCKET & MINI WHEELER CATEGORIES

All Sprockets and Mini Wheelers will receive an award for participation.

5.2 CHALLENGE, 30+ OPEN WHEEL, JUNIOR SUPERCLASS AND SUPERCLASS CATEGORIES

For Challenge, 30+ Open Wheel, Junior Superclass and Superclass categories, the following will be provided:

Allocation: The Prize Money is issued based on the category run on the day at the event (i.e. if categories are required			
to be merged, such as 8 Girls being merged with 9 Girls, then they are issued based on the merged category, which			
would be 9 Girls).

Allocation: The Prize Money is issued based on the category entered (i.e. if categories are required to be merged, such as Junior Superclass Women being merged with Junior Superclass Men, then prizing is issued based on the results of the riders for the category that they entered, being Junior Superclass Women or Junior Superclass Men).

For Superclass & Junior Superclass categories 100% payback will be based on the entries per gender (i.e. 100% of male Superclass entry fees will go into the male Superclass prize pool, and 100% of female Superclass entry fees will go into the female Superclass prize pool).

5.3 DISTRIBUTION OF AWARDS / PRIZE MONEY

Mini Wheelers, Sprockets, Challenge and 30+ Open Wheel categories will be issued their awards/prize money on the day at the conclusion of the final (or last race for each category).

Junior Superclass and Superclass categories will receive their prize money via EFT (as soon as is reasonably practical following the event). Riders are to provide their bank details via email to mvbmx@hotmail.com

The following are prohibited at ACT/NSW State Series Rounds:

- Pets
- Alcohol
- Smoking (including E-Cigarettes or other vaping devices)

Failure to do so, or to follow any reasonable direction provided by Manning Valley BMX Club or appointed officials at the event, may result in removal from the venue or exclusion from competition.
