

^{**}After accreditation is completed in one discipline the common modules are not required to be completed however the discipline specific modules and practical assessment must be undertaken to gain accreditation in another discipline.

^{***} The Regional Road and Track Commissaire Courses requires a multi-step accreditation to pursue the National Course. CA Level 1 Commissaires must undertake these additional practical requirements to be fully qualified to undertake the National Road or Track Commissaire Courses
