

EVENT PARKING INFORMATION

Please note that parking at the venue is very limited. We ask that everyone is patient and allow sufficient time to ensure you can reach the venue on time.



RESERVED PARKING AREA

The reserved parking area is outlined on the [site plan](#) and is only available to individuals provided with a parking pass. This parking pass must be displayed on the dash of the vehicle.

ACCESSIBLE PARKING AREA

The accessible parking area is outlined on the [site plan](#) and is only permitted for individuals who hold an Australian Disability Parking Permit. This parking permit must be displayed on the dash of the vehicle.

GENERAL PARKING AREA

The general parking area is outlined on the [site plan](#) and is accessible between 345 and 347 St Leonards Rd, St Leonards. This parking area will also be signposted on St Leonards Rd to show the access point. There will be a \$2 fee per vehicle for the parking area, which goes to the landowner.

Event attendees are reminded to be respectful of residents in the area, by keeping noise to a minimum and obeying the requests of parking marshals.

The City of Launceston requests that event attendees do not park in any other location along St Leonards Rd or other side streets, and that they are considerate of locals in the area.

AusCycling takes no responsibility for cars parked illegally or for any items left inside vehicles.

PARKING DROP-OFF / PICK-UP AREA



A parking drop-off/pick-up area has been established to assist event attendees when unloading items (i.e. bikes) and passengers at the venue.

There is to be no parking in this drop-off/pick-up area and event attendees are requested to ensure they obey the 2 minute maximum stopping time to allow this area to flow.

Please follow the direction of parking marshals in this area, and ensure you are aware of your surroundings, as there will be heavy foot traffic in the drop-off/pick-up area.

It is also requested that event attendees be mindful of the potential congestion in the drop-off/pick-up area. Attendees are encouraged to allow sufficient time each day, while also noting the venue open times listed on the [Event Schedule](#).

SHUTTLE BUSES

Two shuttle buses with trailers will be operating to pick-up/drop-off event attendees between the venue and the general parking area.

The venue pick-up/drop-off point is at the CNR of St Leonards Rd and the exit to the drop off zone (opposite Celery Top Dr).



The general parking pick-up/drop-off point is in the turning circle at the entry to the parking area.



During peak times each day, the shuttle buses will depart from each location on the hour and then every five (5) minutes thereafter. During non-peak times each day, the shuttle buses will depart as required.

Please be respectful of the shuttle drivers and ensure you leave the buses clean by taking any rubbish with you.
