### **EVENT OVERVIEW**

### GENERAL

#### **Registration**

Saturday

Registration is available from 7:30am at Commercial Hotel, 410 Kingston Rd, Kingston


#### Race Numbers & Transponder

Each competitor will be issued with two body numbers , 1 frame number and a transponder.

Numbers must NOT be cut, folded or modified in any way.

Riders must wear both number, one on each the left and right-side pockets. Frame numbers to be fitted to the rear seat post or the rear brake assembly for both events clearly visible from the side.

The transponder is to be securely mounted with a cable tie on the front fork as low as possible, 40 to 45 cm from the ground. Failure to attach the transponder may result in a delay of the result.









Mount as low as practicable on either fork

It is the riders' responsibility to return their transponder after they finish/abandon the race.

Transponders that are not returned at the event conclusion need to be posted asap to: **AUSCYCLING**, **281 DAREBIN RD**, **THORNBURY**, **3071**, **VIC**.

Late return fee (more than 7 days after event): \$30. Lost transponder fee: \$125

#### Abandoning the Race

Riders abandoning the race must report to an official at the start/finish area and hand in all their numbers and transponder. Failure to do so may result in a \$50 fine.

#### Sign-On

All riders will be required to sign on at the start area at least 30min before the event.

#### Feed Zone

A feed and littering zone will be set up straight after the start area in Kingston. Please refer to the venue map below.

Any rider caught littering outside the designated area will be fined \$100 and may be disqualified.

#### **Spares**

There will be no spares vehicles for any category.

Riders in all other categories who have a mechanical during the road race will be collected by the tail vehicle or can carry a spare tube to change it themselves.

Any rider who receives outside assistance from anyone other than appointed officials will face disqualification and possible fine.

#### Follow Vehicles

A condition of the permits issued for the event from Victoria Police and Vicroads is that **NO** vehicles other than **OFFICAL** vehicles will be allowed to follow the race.

Only **OFFICIAL** race photographers, motorcycle scouts and race officials will be allowed to competitors.

#### **Race Neutralisation**

If for any reason conditions warrant, the Road Race will be neutralised. In such circumstances a red flag will be displayed from the lead vehicle.

#### **Presentations & Awards**

The top three placegetters as well as the top placed team in each category will be required for presentations. Riders shall wear their competition clothing (official team shorts and jersey) or other official team clothing.

Presentations will be held at conclusion of Wave 1 and Wave 2

### REGULATIONS

### GENERAL

- 1. As this is an AusCycling sanctioned event, <u>UCI</u> and <u>AusCycling Technical Regulations</u> (General and Road), policies and penalties apply. Riders will not be able to participate unless their bikes are compliant with technical regulations. Any riders breaching these regulations will be disqualified during or after the event.
- 2. This event forms part of the 2022 TAC Victorian Road Series (VJRS) and will run according to the 2022 TAC Victorian Road Series Regulations.
- 3. As this event is conducted on open roads, all bicycles must have an appropriate red light fitted and operating on either the seat post or right rear seat stay of their bike. The light must be operational during the entire event and visible from 200 metres to the rear.
- 4. An Australian Standards approved (AS/NZ 2063) helmet shall be worn at all times whilst riding a bicycle on open roads (*Local Police as well as AC Officials will issue fines to riders who do not observe this Law*)
- 5. All competitors are reminded that it is an **offence to urinate within view of the public**. The penalty is disqualification from the event, a \$100 fine and their license suspended for 4 weeks (Local Police as well as AC Officials may issue fines to riders who do not observe this Law).
- 6. Littering is against the regulations of the sport of cycling. Any rider who **drops**, throws or discards rubbish may be disqualified from the event and fined \$100.
- 7. Police permits for events conducted on 'Open Roads', require all competitors to keep left at all times (except Criterium).
- 8. Any competitor detected who purposely crosses 'Double continuous dividing lines' will be disqualified from the event, fined \$100 and their license will be suspended for 4 weeks. Competitors who cross the nominal centre of a roadway may be fined \$100 for the first offence, second offence will be disqualification, fined \$200 and report to AusCycling for disciplinary action.
- Cameras attached to a competitor's bicycle are allowed. The <u>camera must be presented on</u> <u>the bike to the Chief Commissaire before the start of the event</u>. The Chief Commissaire must approve the use of the camera prior to use.
- 10. If required, any competitors elected, will submit themselves to anti-doping control conducted by Sports Integrity Australia SIA, under the guidelines set out by the UCI.
- 11. The Broom Wagon will follow the last rider on the course. Should any rider have a mechanical failure that cannot be fixed, the Clean-Up Wagon will retrieve them and drop



them back to the Race headquarters. Riders who are deemed to be too far behind the peloton may be pulled from the race by the clean-up wagon – this will be at the commissaires discretion.

### **EVENT SPECIFIC RULES**

#### **Team Classification**

The team classification in all VRS categories is open to all registered UCI, NRS and VRS teams. The team classification will be calculated based on individual riders results as per UCI Regulation 2.6.016:

"The team classification for the day shall be calculated on the basis of the sum of the three best individual times from each team".
