

AusCycling BMX Club Officials Course

Pre-Requisites and General Information

Before you can start the course, you must be:

1. Aged 16+
2. A current AusCycling member of at least non-riding category. Membership details can be found [HERE](#)

Course Cost:

There is no cost to take the AusCycling BMX Club Officials course.

Pre-Requisites:

Hold a valid **Working with Children Check** (or equivalent) as per your state/territory requirements.

A Working With Children Check (or equivalent) ('WWCC'), in accordance with your state/territory legislation, is mandatory to complete your accreditation. You may start the BMX Club Officials course without completing your WWCC, however your accreditation will not issue until your WWCC (or equivalent) is uploaded into the AusCycling e-learning system and marked as complete.

- a) If you are under the minimum age of requiring a WWCC in your state/territory, please upload your AusCycling membership card to confirm your age when requested to provide the WWCC.
- b) If you are exempt from holding a WWCC in your state/territory, please upload your WWCC proof of exemption for this pre-requisite (e.g. teacher registration). For Western Australia only a [Member Protection Declaration](#) may be used for those who have an exemption.

The age(s) at which a WWCC is required and where to apply for each state/territory is listed below.

- South Australia – 14 years +: [Working with Children Check](#)
- Northern Territory – 15 years + [Working with Children Clearance](#)
- ACT – 16 years + [Working with Vulnerable People Application](#)
- Tasmania – 16 years + [Working with Vulnerable People Application](#)
