1 OVERVIEW

The AusCycling Junior Road State Series events are a critical part of the Racing competition structure and pathway. The following are the series specific regulations for Queensland

2 SERIES ROUNDS

- Round 1 : 10 - 11 June: Gold Coast Junior Tour hosted by Gold Coast CC
- Round 2: 24 - 25 June – Balmoral Junior Tour hosted by Balmoral CC
- Round 3 : 8 - 9 July – Great Northern Tour hosted by Townsville CC
- Round 4 : 25 – 27 August – Junior Tour hosted by Hamilton Wheelers/ Lifecycle CC / Ipswich CC

3 SERIES QUALIFICATION

The minimum qualification for the Queensland series is two (2) rounds

- In order to have your place recognised in the Queensland Junior Road Series points:
 - The rider must be a primary member of a club in Queensland. Participation in all events is open to all riders within the appropriate age groups.
 - The rider must have earned points to appear in the series standings
 - The rider must not be registered in a Junior Road Series of a different state during the same season
 - A rider can only pursue one State or Territory series in a season. Riders are only eligible for the series in the State/Territory in which their primary club is situated (allocated) unless exempted by AusCycling, as a result of relocation to a new State or Territory.
 - Exemptions must be requested via email to events@auscycling.org.au.

4 SERIES POINTS

The points for Queensland will be awarded based on the finishing place on General Classification, in accordance with the table below:

4.1 BONUS POINTS

Bonus points will be awarded in all categories:

- for each stage at all tours (rounds 1-4) as follows:

Place	Points
1 st	8
2 nd	5
3 rd	4
4 th	3
5 th	2
6 th	1

5 SERIES POINTS CALCULATION

Series points will be calculated by adding the total points from each event plus any bonus points awarded.

5.1 RIDING UP

Riding up is not permitted in Series events.

5.2 COMBINED CATEGORIES

In the scenario where categories have been combined at an event (for whatever reason), points will be awarded separately. For example, if JB13 / JG 13 are combined into one race the riders will be separated for points in their category.

If age groups are separated into A & B Grades, the full State Series Points will be applied to A grade, with B grade receiving 50% of the full points allocation.

5.3 TIE BREAK

When competitors share the same number of total series points ties will be broken using the following method:

1. The number of 1st places achieved
2. The number of 2nd places achieved
3. The number of 3rd places achieved

6 EVENT CATEGORIES

The Event Categories that must be conducted within each Series round and will be recognised accordingly in Series points, are as listed below:

Junior 17 (Men)	2007-2008
Junior 15 (Male)	2009-2010

Junior 15 (Female)	2009-2010
Junior 13 (Male)	2011-2012
Junior 13 (Female)	2011-2012

Junior 11 & Junior 9 will not be part of the Series but be recognised by the host club.

7 GRADING

The series is ungraded however A & B grading may be used based on entries and race format.

8 STATE SERIES AWARDS

Riders the recognised categories who meet the Series Qualification requirements and finish in the below mentioned placings will receive the following prizing:

Trophies	1st Place, 2nd Place, 3rd Place

8.1 AWARD PRESENTATIONS

Awards will be presented at the conclusion of the final round

9 EVENT AWARDS

For each round of the Series the Host Club will provide the awards. Information pertaining to the exact awards being issued for each round will be outlined in the round specific Technical Guide.
