2.1 ENTRY PROCESS & COST

Entry will be online via EntryBoss only. Entries will be uploaded into Sqorz after entries have closed. It is the rider's/rider's guardian's responsibility to ensure that their entry is correct. This includes transponder number, category, and plate number.

2.2 TRANSPONDERS

- All riders (except sprockets) will need to provide their own transponder to enter this event.
- 20" and 24" bikes will need separate transponders unless prior approval has been received.
- It is the rider's responsibility to ensure that the transponder is correctly fitted to their bike and is operational which includes an active <u>subscription</u>.
- Transponders can be purchased <u>here</u>.

2.3 EVENT REGISTRATION (SIGN ON)

- All riders are required to attend the Event Registration.
- All riders must take their bikes to the transponder checking station to register for the event.
- Riders entered in two (2) categories (i.e. 20" and 24") must take both bikes to register in both categories.
- It is the responsibility of the rider/parent/guardian to check all details are correct at the transponder checking station.

3 RACE INFORMATION

3.1 RACE FORMAT

A category of one (1) full gate or less (i.e. eight (8) riders or less riders) will be run in accordance with section 2.03.03 a) of the <u>AusCycling Technical Regulations – BMX</u>.

The race format for the Maryborough BMX Club 2023 Open Day is as follows:

4.3 DISTRIBUTION OF AWARDS / PRIZE MONEY

<u>GAZEBOS</u>: Allowed- Will be positioned 1.5m from each other in pre-determined marked out spaces. <u>Bore Water Only- Non-Drinkable</u>

Pump Track: The Maryborough BMX Club Pump Track will be closed during racing, and when it is ridden it will be not supervised by Maryborough BMX. It will be ridden under supervision of parents only. If it is ridden while racing in underway you will be disqualified from the open day.
