**Age/ Vet Pro:** \$150 prize pool per class pay 1-8 (1st \$50, 2nd \$30, 3rd \$20, 4th – 8th \$10)

Junior Superclass:\$50 - Per Event - Pay on Day plus paybackSuperclass:\$200 - Per Event - Pay on Day plus payback

**Gold Cup:** Trophy 1<sup>st</sup>, Medallions 2<sup>nd</sup> – 8<sup>th</sup>

### **CONDITIONS OF ENTRY:**

- All Riders must hold a Current AusCycling All Discipline Membership or Off-Road Membership
- Age Determination is at 31<sup>st</sup> December 2023
- Transponders will be used for Scoring. Riders must supply their own transponders. Sprockets/Mini Wheelers do
  not require a transponder. It is the riders responsibility to ensure their transponder is working and fitted
  correctly. If a transponder fails, riders will be scored DNF
- 3 Riders Constitutes a Class. Classes undersubscribed will be merged but scored as per entered class.
- Consolation Finals will be held for all classes with more than 8 Riders.
- Event will be run as a series over the two days. Riders can ride one event but must ride both events in the same class to qualify for awards. Mini Wheelers/Sprockets will not be scored but will be eligible for awards if qualified
- Classes run in accordance with AusCycling Technical Regulations BMX 2.03.02(a) and 2.03.03(a)
- Tiebreakers will be resolved by countback in accordance with AusCycling Technical Regulations BMX 2.03.05
