3 EVENT ENTRIES

3.1 EVENT CATEGORIES

The below categories will be run for the 2023 Hutsix BMX State Series. For a category to be held, at least four (4) riders must be registered in that category.

Challenge (20")	Male/Female	8, 9, 10, 11, 12, 13, 14, 15, 16, 17-24, 25-29, 30-34, 35-39, 40-44, 45-49, 50-54, 55-59, 60+
Challenge (Cruiser)	Male/Female	8-10, 11-12, 13-14, 15-16, 17-24, 25-29, 30-34, 35-39, 40-44, 45-49, 50-54, 55-59, 60+
Vet Pro	Male/Female	30+
Junior Superclass	Male/Female	14-16
Superclass	Male/Female	16+

Please Note: In accordance with the <u>AusCycling Technical Regulations: BMX</u>

3.2 ENTRY PROCESS & COST

Entry will be online via Entryboss only. Entries will be uploaded into Sqorz after entries have closed. It is the rider/rider's guardian's responsibility to ensure that their entry is correct. This includes transponder number, category, and plate number.

3.3 SCRATCHING & REFUNDS

Riders who have entered and are no longer able to attend, must request a refund via email to nsw.bmx@auscycling.org.au, with a copy of their medical certificate attached. The refund request and medical certificate must be received by AusCycling prior to race day (for clarity this is prior to 29 July 2023). For more information, please view the AusCycling Refund Policy.

3.4 CORPORATE TEAMS

Information on Corporate Team entry is not applicable for ACT/NSW State Series Racing

3.5 MEMBERSHIP

The events will be open to all riders holding an AusCycling Race Membership: All Disciplines or Off Road only. No four (4) week trial or day licenses are permitted.

3.6 TRANSPONDERS

- All riders (except Sprockets and Mini Wheelers) will need to provide their own transponder to enter this event.
- 20" and 24" bikes will need separate transponders unless prior approval has been received.
- It is the rider's responsibility to ensure that the transponder is correctly fitted to their bike and is operational which includes an active <u>subscription</u>. Transponders can be purchased <u>here</u>.

3.7 RACE PLATES

- Riders must ensure they have the correct Race Plate as detailed under section 3.04 of the <u>AusCycling</u> Technical Regulations: BMX
- All Riders will nominate their plate number (maximum 3 digits) when registering.
- Riders with duplicate plates in the same category may be required to add an 'X' on their plate number.
- Where a duplicate plate is identified, the following process will be used:
 - Where riders have an allocated plate number (i.e., 1ACT) and a category is merged, the rider who has earnt the respective plate number in the designated category will keep that plate number, with the other rider required to add an 'X' to their plate or select an alternate plate number.
 - Where riders personally choose a plate number and two (2) or more riders select the same plate number, the following steps shall occur to determine who is required to add an 'X' on their race number, until the duplication is resolved:
 - 1. If a category is merged, the rider who entered into the designated category will keep that plate number.
 - 2. The rider who is a member of the host club will keep that plate number.
 - 3. The rider who is a member of the host state/territory will keep that plate number.
 - 4. The rider who entered the event first will keep that plate number.

3.8 EVENT REGISTRATION (SIGN ON)

- All riders are required to attend the Event Registration (sign on), prior to the commencement of their Official Practice session.
- All riders must take their bikes to the transponder checking station to register for the event.
- Riders entered in two (2) categories (i.e., 20" and 24") must take both bikes to register in both categories.
- Parents/guardians must scan Sprocket/Mini Wheeler membership at the transponder checking station, but they are not required to bring bikes with them.
- It is the responsibility of the rider/parent/guardian to check all details are correct at the transponder checking station.

4 RACE INFORMATION

4.1 RULES AND REGULATIONS

The event will be conducted under the BMX rules and regulations of AusCycling (AC) and the Union Cycliste Internationale (UCI). This Technical Guide is supplementary to the following:

- AusCycling Technical Regulations: General
- <u>AusCycling Technical Regulations:</u> BMX
- <u>UCI Regulations BMX</u>

4.2 SCORING

Transponders and a finish line camera will be used at this event to capture results

Sqorz will be used to record and publish results

4.3 RACE FORMAT

Current UCI Rules applies using Scrambled Moto transfer system for all categories except for participation. Block format may apply pending rider entries. Gate positions for Motos will be random computer drawn. Total points to end of motos followed by Qualifiers and Finals. Gate positions for Qualifiers and Finals are in order of lap time from the previous Stage or Round.

A category of one (1) full gate or less (i.e. eight (8) riders or less riders) will be run in accordance with section 2.03.03 a) of the <u>AusCycling Technical Regulations: BMX</u>.

The race format for the State/Territory Championships is as follows:

Category	Race Format
Mini Wheelers / Sprockets	4 Motos
Challenge / Vet Pro / Junior Superclass / Superclass	3 Motos, Qualifiers, Finals

4.4 RIDERS ADVOCATE / PROTESTS

4.4.1 APPOINTMENT AND ROLE OF RIDERS ADVOCATE

A Riders Advocate (also known as Team Manager) will be appointed by the Technical Delegate for the 2023 Hutsix BMX ACT/NSW State Series Events. The Riders Advocate represents a rider in relation to appeals concerning procedural matters. Where there are large number of riders attending the event, the Technical Delegate may also appoint additional Assistant Riders Advocates, in order to assist the Riders Advocate in their role.

4.4.2 PROCESS TO LODGE A PROTEST

All riders must approach the Riders Advocate to speak to officials if they have an issue / lodge a protest on their behalf. Protests can only be made on the results from the scoring medium showing the order in which the riders crossed the finish line, not the decisions of the commissaires panel that are noted in the results such as DNS (Did Not Start), DNF (Did Not Finish), REL (Relegated). Riders only have 15 minutes to protest once results are posted.

Protests regarding judgment decisions during a competition are not accepted. The commissaires in charge shall make decisions on the spot through the president of the commissaires' panel in case of any incidents or irregularities occurring during the competition.

5 AWARDS & PRIZING

5.1 AWARDS & PRIZES PROVIDED

The following will be provided:

Category	Award/Prize	Placing
Sprocket/Miniwheeler	Award	All riders who participated in the event
Challenge (20"/Cruiser)	Prize Money	1st Place (\$50), 2nd Place (\$30), 3rd Place (\$20), 4th – 8th Place (\$10)
Vet Pro	Prize Money	1st Place (\$100), 2nd Place (\$60), 3rd Place (\$40), 4th – 8th Place (\$10)

Allocation: The Prize Money is issued based on the category run on the day at the event (i.e. if categories are required to be merged, such as 8 Girls being merged with 9 Girls, then they are issued based on the merged category, which would be 9 Girls).

Junior Superclass	Prize Pool*	1st Place (33%), 2nd Place (23%), 3rd Place (14%), 4th Place (8%), 5th Place (7%), 6th Place (6%), 7th Place (5%), 8th Place (4%)
Superclass	Prize Pool^	1st Place (33%), 2nd Place (23%), 3rd Place (14%), 4th Place (8%), 5th Place (7%), 6th Place (6%), 7th Place (5%), 8th Place (4%)

^{* \$500} prize pool i.e. \$250 for men \$250 for women, plus 100% payback less AusCycling Fees

Allocation: The Prize Money is issued based on the category entered (i.e., if categories are required to be merged, such as Junior Superclass Women being merged with Junior Superclass Men, then prizing is issued based on the results of the riders for the category that they entered, being Junior Superclass Women or Junior Superclass Men).

For Superclass &; Junior Superclass categories 100% payback will be based on the entries per gender (i.e. 100% of male Superclass entry fees will go into the male Superclass prize pool, and 100% of female Superclass entry fees will go into the female Superclass prize pool).

5.2 DISTRIBUTION OF AWARDS & PRIZING

Mini Wheelers, Sprockets, Challenge and Vet Pro categories will be issued their awards/prize money on the day at the conclusion of the final (or last race for each category).

Junior Superclass and Superclass categories will receive their prize money via EFT, within twenty-one (21) days of the conclusion of the event (subject to Riders providing their details in the listed timeframe). Riders are to provide their bank details via email to sanremobmxclub@gmail.com
