# NATIONAL CHAMPION JERSEY



# Introduction

Being awarded the National Champion Jersey and Kit is an honour for any rider. Strict rules from the UCI and AusCycling govern the manufacture and wearing of the National Champion jersey and kit. The following outlines the design and ability to wear the National Champion jersey/kit and champion bands.

## Regulations

An Australian Champion Jersey shall be awarded to the highest placed Australian in all events.

Winners may wear their Australian Champion Jersey in all events in the discipline specialty and category in which they won their title and no other event up until the day before the championship event of the following year.

Masters riders may wear this jersey in all masters competitions conducted in the discipline in which the national championship was won.

BMX Racing Challenge class riders may wear the jersey or sleeve in the event they are Australian Champion (20" or Cruiser) for the following year even if they have moved up age category.

When a rider no longer holds the title of Australian Champion the rider may wear piping in national colours on the collar and cuffs of their jersey in the events of the discipline in which they won the title.

The piping must follow the following design:

### Elite and Para-Cycling

- Green, Gold, Green – 33mm width
- PMS colours must match –
  - ✓ Wattle (#EDED06, 237/237/6, 395 C) - Yellow
  - ✓ Brunswick (#02534D, 2/83/77, 323 C) - Green

### All other Championships

- Gold, Green, Gold – 33mm width
- PMS colours must match –
  - ✓ Wattle (#EDED06, 237/237/6, 395 C) - Yellow
  - ✓ Brunswick (#02534D, 2/83/77, 323 C) - Green

## Intellectual Property

AusCycling has taken many steps to protect its intellectual property, including trademark registration, copyright and enforcement action against third parties using its intellectual property without AusCycling's consent.

Included in its Trademark portfolio AusCycling is the registered proprietor of Trademark 1954214 being the green and yellow stripes applied to the national championship jerseys, shorts and bibs, as depicted below:

No organisation other than AusCycling can authorise use of its intellectual property. Where third parties wish to use the Trademark on the national championship jersey (or sell a national championship jersey featuring the Trademark), it must seek first the approval from AusCycling stating the nature, term and extent of the proposed use. AusCycling may approve, reject or conditionally approve any request to use the Trademark on jerseys and/or items featuring the Trademark. Where an Elite or Para-Cycling Champion individual or team designs their own national champion jersey the following elements must be followed:

- The jersey must be White
- The sleeves must be Gold
- Knicks and skinsuit bottoms may be black or team colours
- 33mm Green and Gold bands across the body (no advertising permitted on the bands)
- Green and Gold bands on the collar and sleeves (33mm width)
- PMS colours must match: Wattle (#EDED06, 237/237/6, 395 C) – Gold/Yellow  
Brunswick (#02534D, 2/83/77, 323 C) – Green

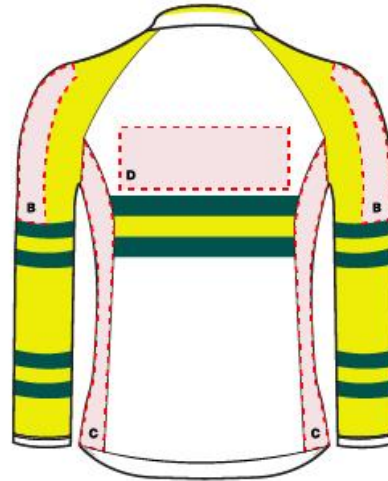

Where non-Elite category individual or team designs their own national champion jersey the following elements must be followed:

- The jersey must be White
- The sleeves must be Green
- Knicks and skinsuit bottoms may be black or team colours
- 33mm Gold and Green bands across the body (no advertising permitted on the bands)
- Gold and Green bands on the collar and sleeves (33mm width)
- PMS colours must match: Wattle (#EDED06, 237/237/6, 395 C) – Gold/Yellow  
Brunswick (#02534D, 2/83/77, 323 C) – Green

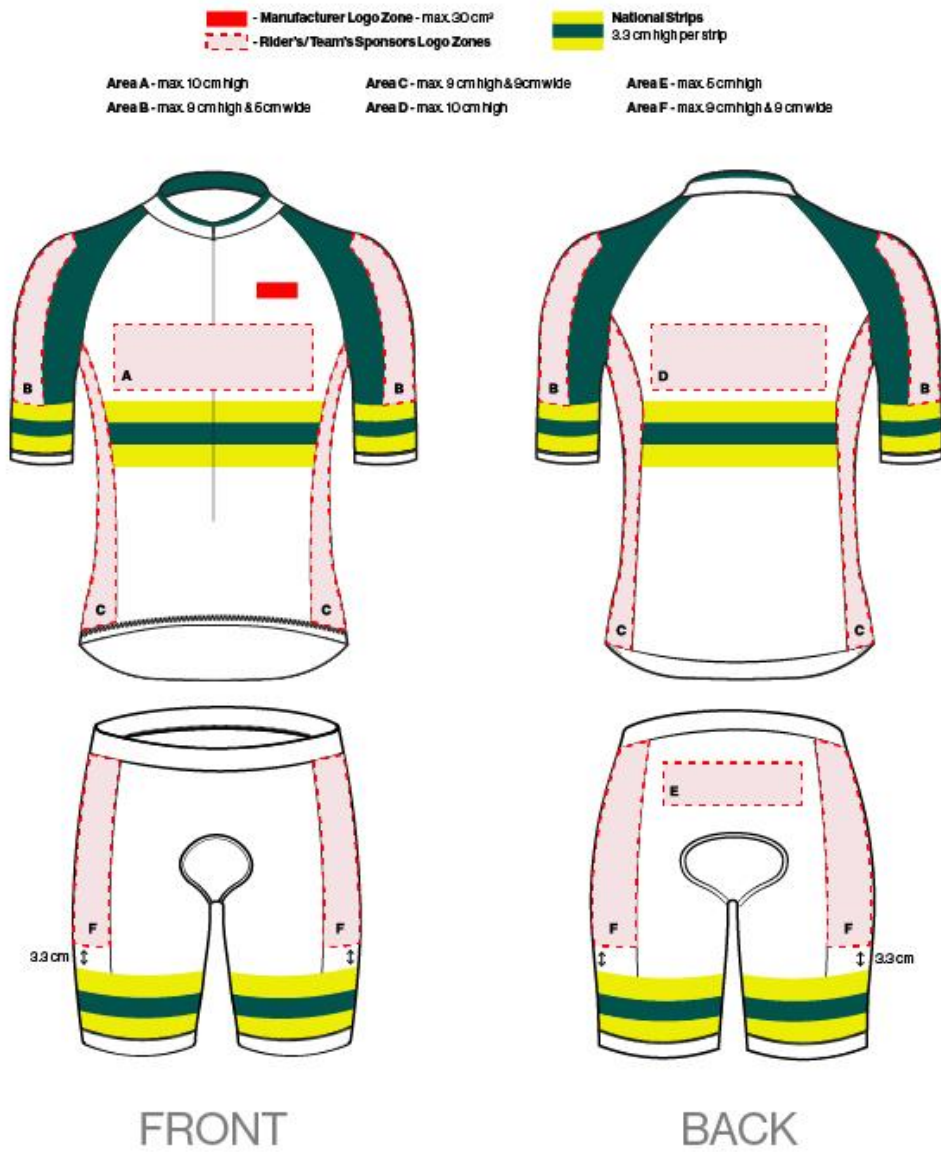

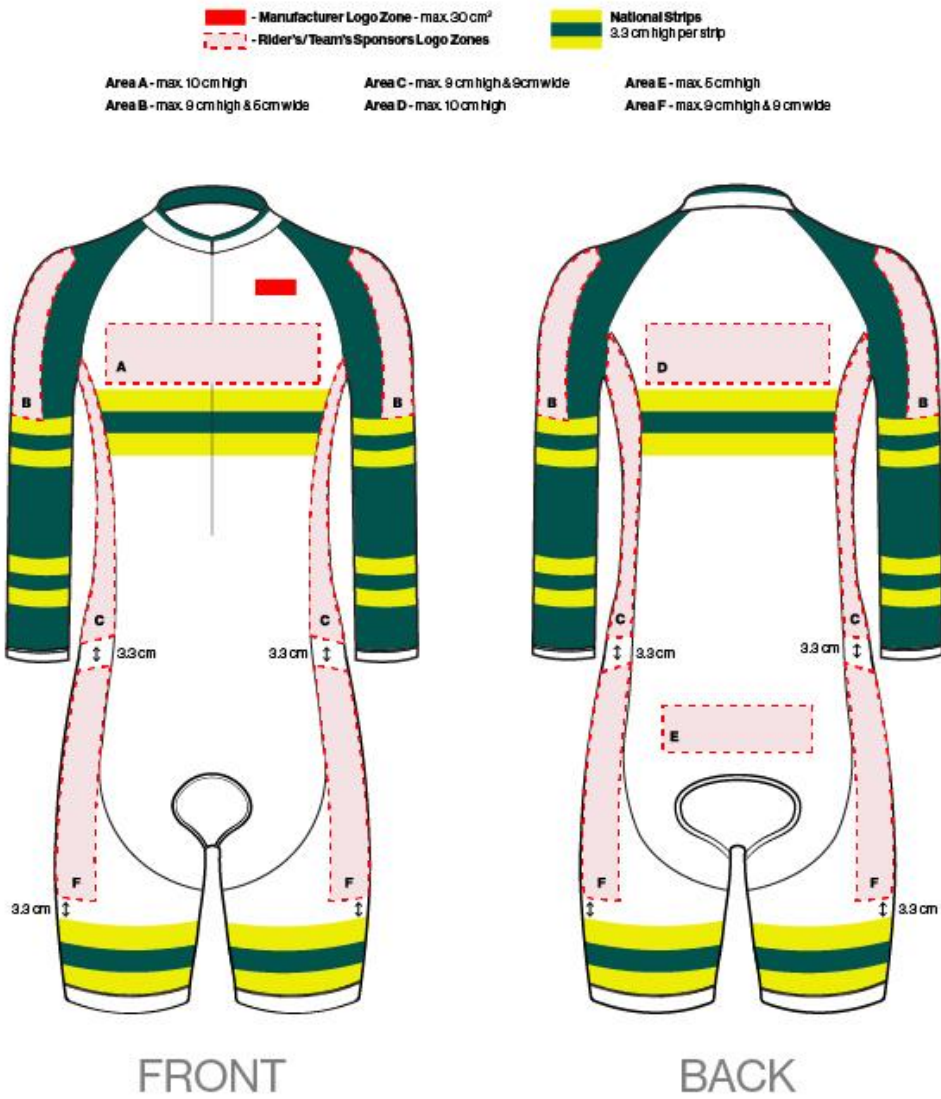
